Artist/Crafter Space Guidelines **Morven Park, Leesburg, VA** **June 23, 11am – 9pm & June 24, 11am – 7pm**

ASSIGNMENTS AND SETUP: Booths are 10'x10' spaces unless otherwise agreed upon and the exact location will be available at Check-In. Artist/Crafters **must** remain in their assigned area and occupy their booths during open hours of the event.

Check In Times: 11:00 AM - 3:00 PM on Friday, June 22, 2012
7:00 AM - 9:00 AM on Saturday, June 23, 2012

Check-in on Thursday, June 23, 2011, may be possible with prior arrangement with Management.

*Included in the booth fee, each artist/crafter will receive two (2) sampling glasses and wrist bands per day. Only exhibitors of legal drinking age may receive the wrist bands and glasses. These will be provided at check-in and proper identification **must** be shown.*

TENTS, TABLES, CHAIRS: Artist/Crafters may provide their own tents and other equipment. All tents must be staked securely in the ground. Management will provide the following per 10'x10' space: one (1) 8' table, two (2) chairs, and receptacles for the removal of trash and recyclable materials. **Artist/Crafters may rent tents, or extra tables and chairs from Management. (A list of equipment and prices will be sent upon request.)**

EXHIBITION SPACE AND LOCATION: Artist/Crafter agrees to conduct all activities within the confines of the assigned display space and to restrict the volume level of electronics and other amplification equipment as well as personnel so as not to interfere with other participants. Artist/Crafter may distribute literature, perform service, and obtain future business leads, but may not solicit and/or accept donations or sell raffle tickets or chance tickets. Artist/Crafter is reminded that the Northern Virginia Summer BrewFest is an outdoor event. All exhibits and/or displays should be produced subject to weather conditions.

EXHIBIT VEHICLES: You must purchase sufficient space for any vehicle used for promotional purposes. Any such vehicle which is located on the field during the event will not be allowed to move until the event is cleared of attendees. (NOTE: Vehicles are not permitted under a tent per fire department regulations.)

CANCELLATION/REFUNDS: There is no rain date and fees are not refundable after June 1, 2012. A \$25.00 administrative fee will be charged for cancellations received between acceptance notification and June 1, 2012.

INSURANCE: Artist/Crafter must provide to The High Road, Inc. a Certificate of Insurance for General Liability Insurance (and Product Liability if applicable) in an amount not less than \$1 million, including Workers' Compensation. **Named Additional Insured** must be: The High Road, Inc., Vintage 50 Restaurant & Brew Lounge, and Morven Park.

ELECTRICAL: Artist/Crafter must provide electrical requests to Management on this form. Artists/Crafters may not run wires to other booths or outlets without approval from Management.

EQUIPMENT REMOVAL AND CLEAN UP: Artist/Crafters are responsible for the day-to-day cleanup of trash in the area around their booth and the appearance of their booth. Trash collection and removal will be provided by Management. Artist/Crafter agrees to remove all merchandise, displays, etc. not later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, June 25, 2012. A cleanup fee of \$200 will be assessed if property is not removed at that time.

PARKING: Parking is permitted in designated areas only and admission to the field and designated parking areas is by permit only. Artist/Crafter will receive a limited number of permits for designated areas that are transferable only within its organization for successive shifts.

SALES TAX: Artist/Crafter is responsible to collect and remit Virginia sales tax on any sales transactions at the event. For information and forms: <http://www.tax.virginia.gov/site.cfm?alias=SalesUseTax#Retail>

NOTE: Vehicles will NOT be allowed into the festival site before the official closing of the festival each day. While our VA ABC permit specifies that beer sampling must stop 60 minutes before the official close, public safety precludes vehicles entering the site prior to the official closing.
